BOATER SAFETY UPDATE **SEPTEMBER 13, 2018**

MILESTONES:

West Channel closed until the end of the project
East Trestle will progress to span 5E the week of September 21, 2018

NOTES:

1. Updated **waterway access**. The 138ft Small Craft Alternative Channel is only permitted from dawn to dusk and will close September 21, 2018.
2. West Trestle construction will start on the West bank and work towards the channel. East Trestle construction will start on the East bank and work towards the channel.
3. Navigation exclusion symbols will be placed on both the upstream and down sides of trestle.
4. Buoys to be placed as shown.
5. East channel will remain open. Channel demarcation and navigation signs have been added to the bridge.

Stay clear of overhead work.
Construction site prohibited.
