MILESTONES: (UPDATED APRIL 17, 2020)

Main Navigation Channel width reduced to 71ft from existing 150ft from May 2020 until October 2020

NOTES:

- 1. Updated waterway access. The 138ft Small Craft Alternative Channel is closed.
- 2. East bank trestle construction is complete and will be removed towards the end of the project.
- 3. Navigation exclusion symbols will be maintained on both the upstream and down sides of trestle.
- 4. Buoys to be placed as shown.
- 5. Main Navigation Channel (formerly East Channel) will remain open. Channel demarcation and navigation signs have been added to the bridge.

WARNINGS:

Stay clear of prohibited areas near construction site. Watch for relocating barges.
